After the Phaeton, the whole Golf class, the Touran and the new Passat, VW has once again extended its range of vehicles with AGR-tested seats. In future, the new VW Tiguan will also be available with the AGR-certified and

therefore back-friendly ergoActiv seat with 14-way adjustment on the driver's side. The company thus shows a clear commitment to the back health of its customers. The seats offer individual possible settings and adjustments, along the lines of adapting the seat to the user, not vice versa. Seat tilt adjustment, 4-way lordosis support, adequate side guidance elements on the backrest and sitting surface, height adjustment, extended seat length and an adjustable headrest are just some of the important requirement criteria for economic sitting comfort. In this way, the ergoActiv seat can be adjusted individually to all possible body sizes.
